The newly formed Thespian Troupe, under the direction of Earl Knickerbocker, consists of all juniors and seniors interested dramatics.



The concert band welcomed the new instruments that were purchased. These included three snare drums, two tympani, a set of chimes, and a new baritone. The latter was also used during marching season.


We had the largest choir in the history of Vassar High this year. The new schedule gave them much more time to prepare for the Christmas concert, which was held in cooperation with the band.






