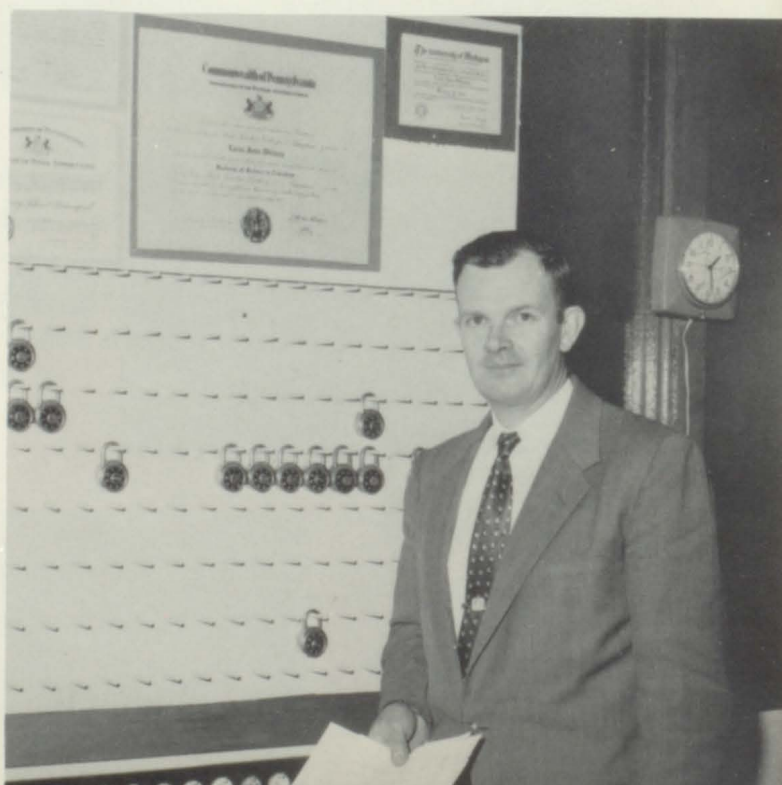


Kathy Lewis
