VHS Band Works Hard

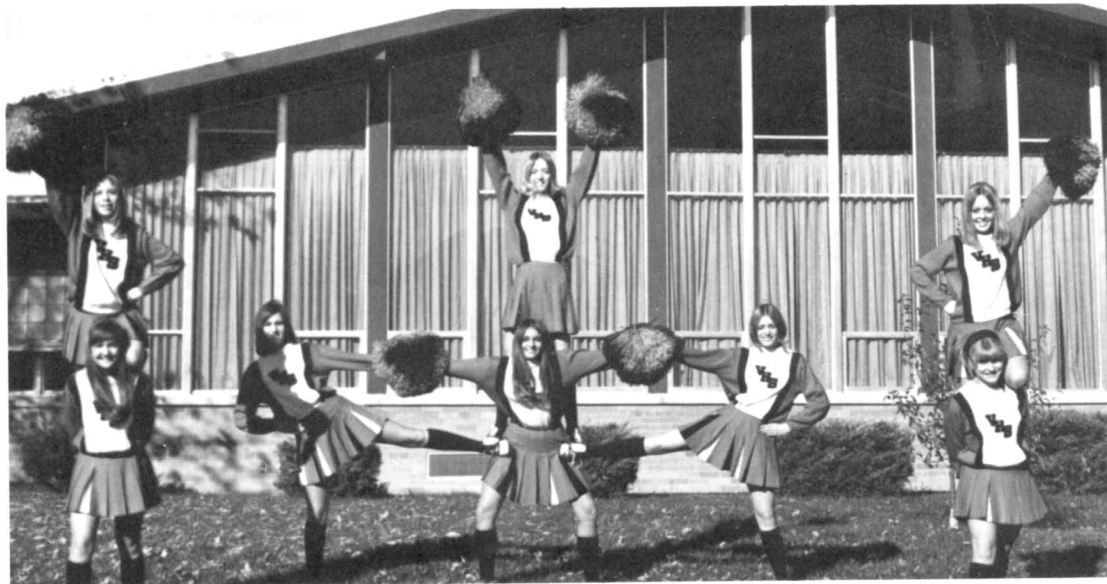

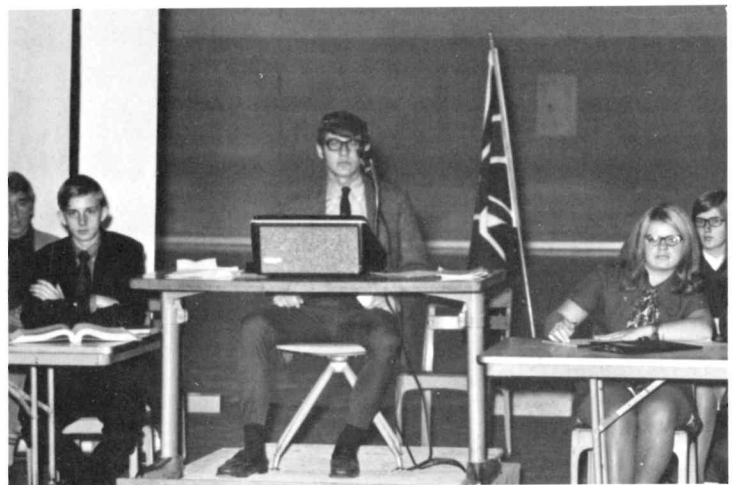
U.N. Day
