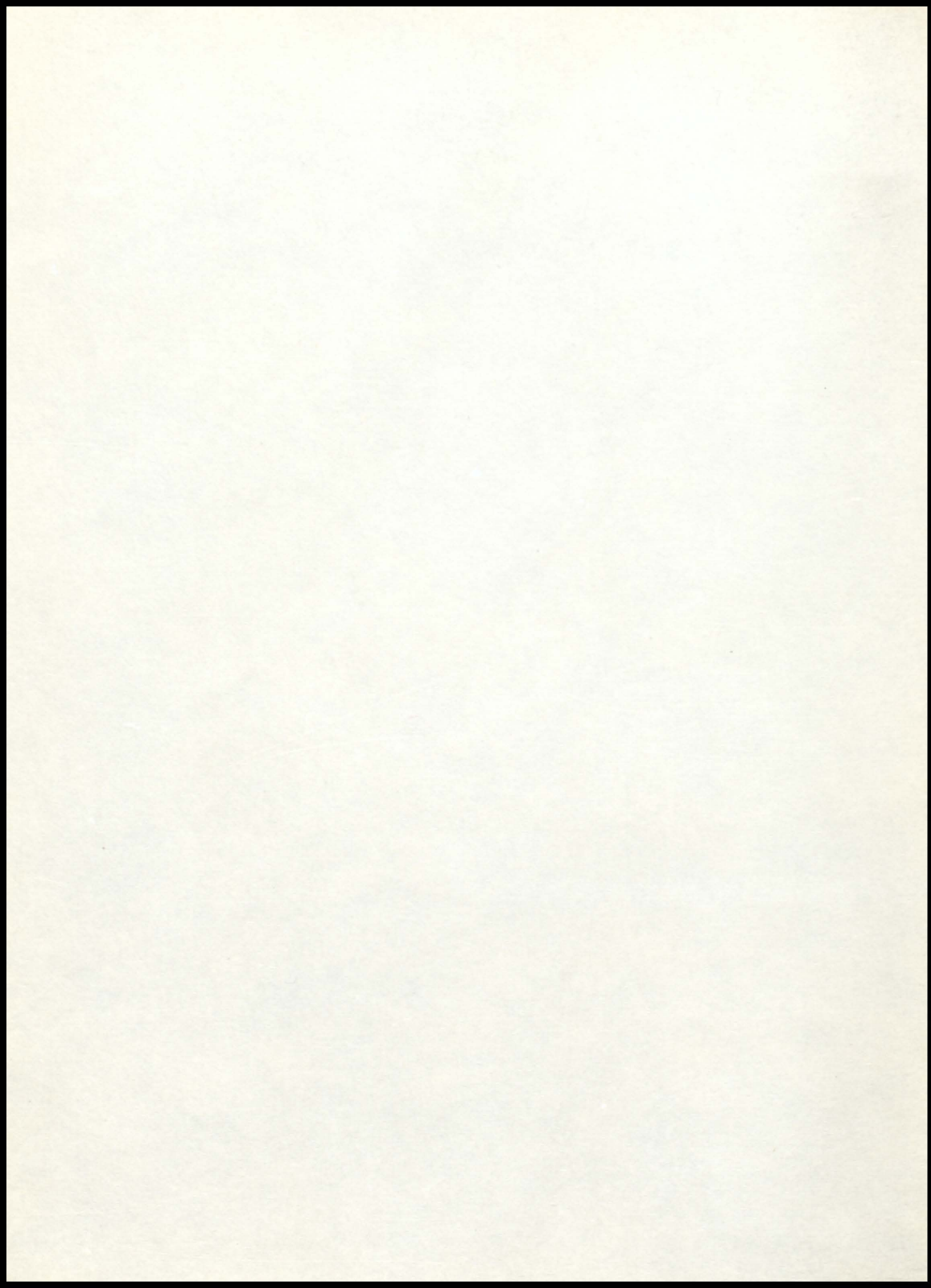

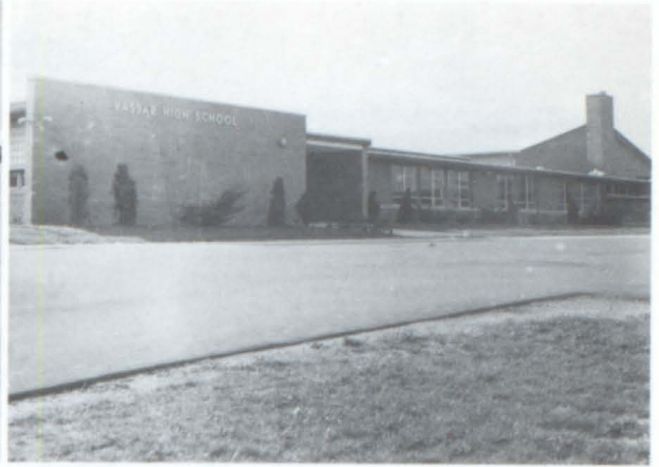

## Foreword

Since this year's Echo is being published during the school's Centennial year, it seems only fitting to look back over the past history of the Vassar schools. The first school was built in 1851 on S. Main Street. A brick school was built in 1860 on "the Hill" where later diplomas were granted in 1871, thereby making this the Centennial year. Most classes were small in the beginning, including the first graduating class, which had only three members.

The McKinley school was next to be built in 1886. In 1917, a fire destroyed the school built in 1860 and the present-day Central school was built in its place. The Central building is still in use, along with our new high school, which was built in 1961.

Vassar's first teacher was Miss Augusta Slafter. She taught for \$1.50 per week and "boarded around" in different homes in the area.

As the schools grew, so did the concept of publishing yearbooks. Probably the first one was printed in 1904 - a paperback booklet with very few pictures but much writing. The yearbooks were often put out by the Senior class. In many years there were no yearbooks, including the period from 1938 to 1947 because of World War II. Since 1947, yearbooks have been printed by a yearbook staff on an annual basis.

The 1971 Yearbook staff prints this history of 100 years of growth and change in our schools as a tribute to our predecessors.



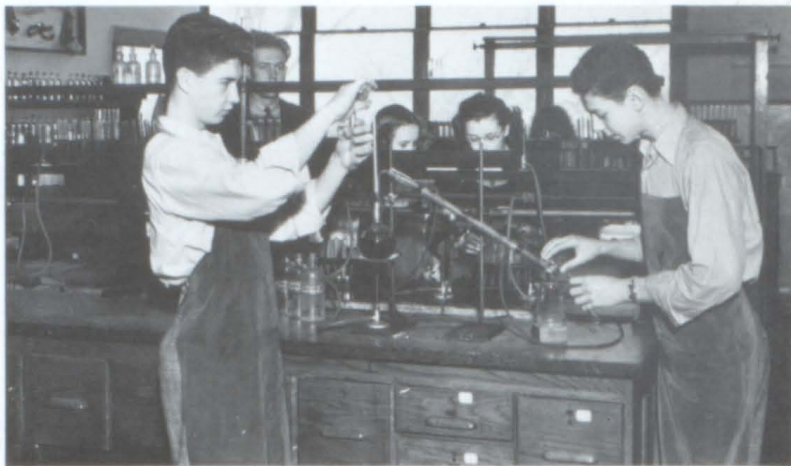
