Dana Clucky was on the second team, and Dave Scribner, Bill Heffelfinger, and Pete Wade made honorable mention. On the first team Defense were Tom Hess, Dave Essenmacher, Matt Fessler, and Mark Laux. Dave Franz made the second team, and Jeff Tetreau and Tim Greenwood were named on honorable mention.



Tom Hess and Bob Laurion both won the Most Valuable Player Award. The Coach's Award went to Bill Heffelfinger. Three-year varsity trophies were given to Deed Eldredge, Dave Franz, Tom Hess, and Dave Scribner.
