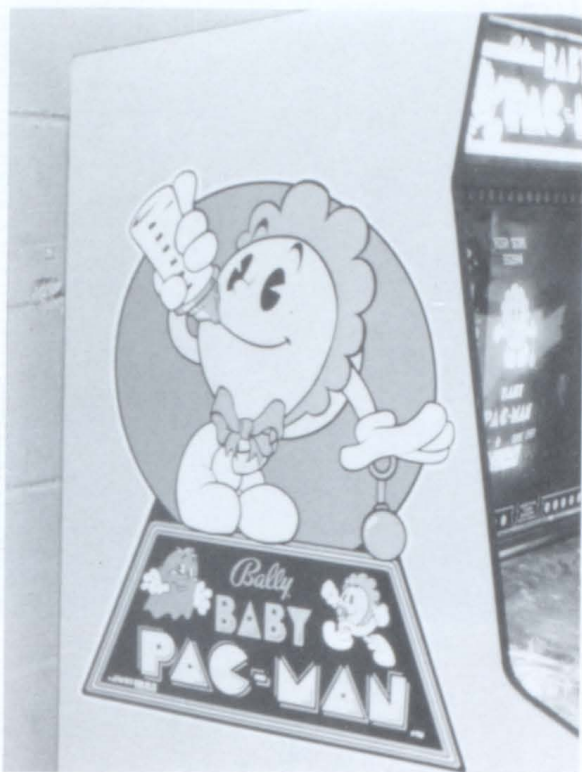
Fads And Fashions Are

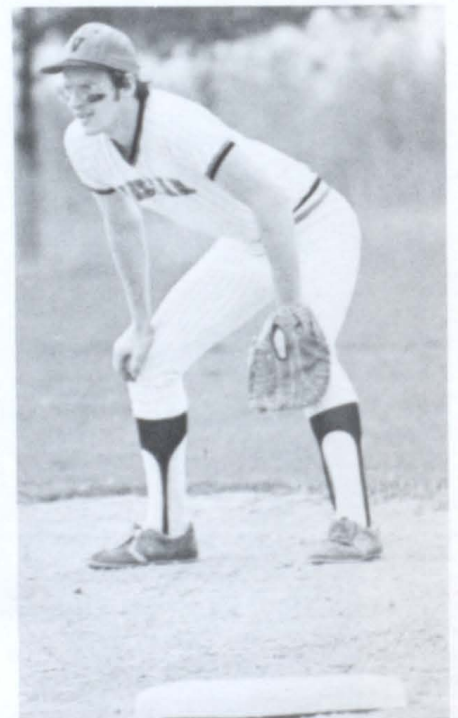
