# Varsity Football

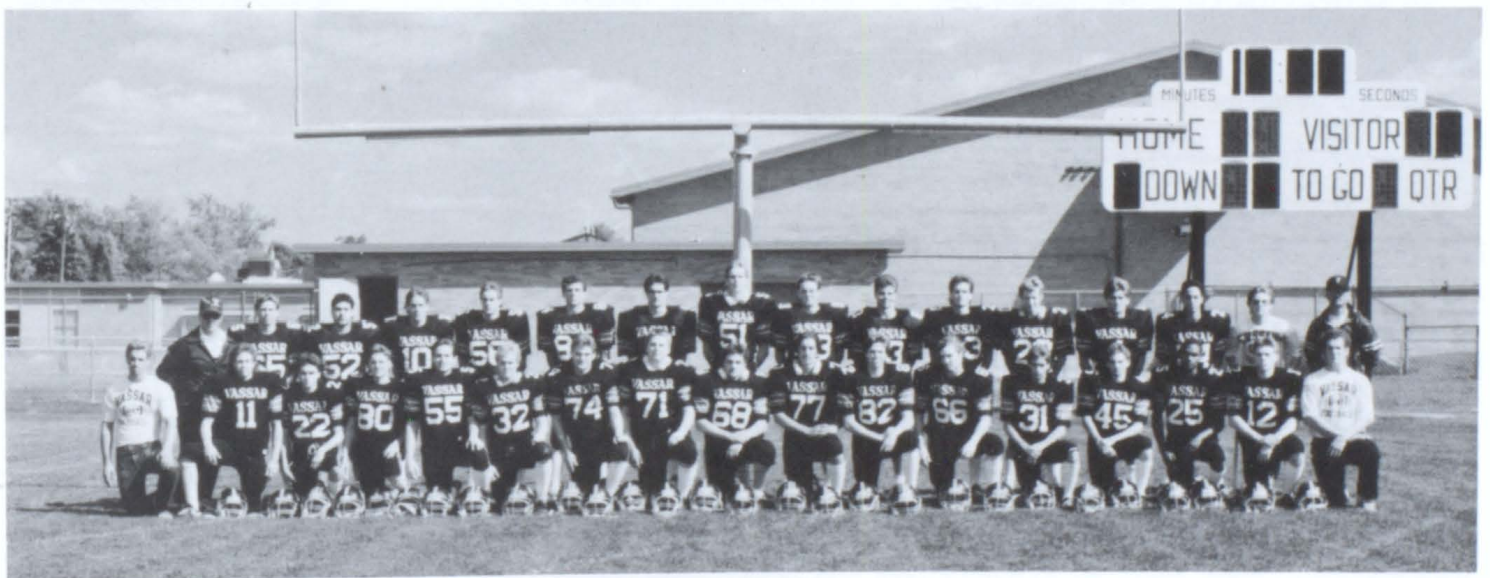

The start of the season turned out fairly well as Vassar had 2 wins and 1 loss after the first three games. The Vulcans were aided by All-Conference Honorable Mention players, Phil Martin, Don Owens, and Chris Emery.

The tables turned for the worse towards the midpoint of the season, but not everything was gloomy. The Vulcans defeated Laker High in an exciting, emotional, well-played game. Second Team All-Conference players, Brent Stuart, Dan Germain, and James Farnum, along with First Team All-Conference players, Mark Bogert, Bob Litner, Brian Cobb, Trent Walker, and Troy Amend aided in the outcome of the season. 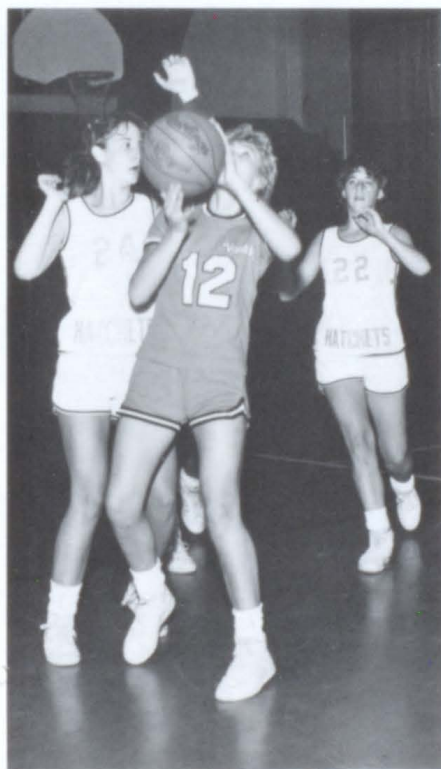

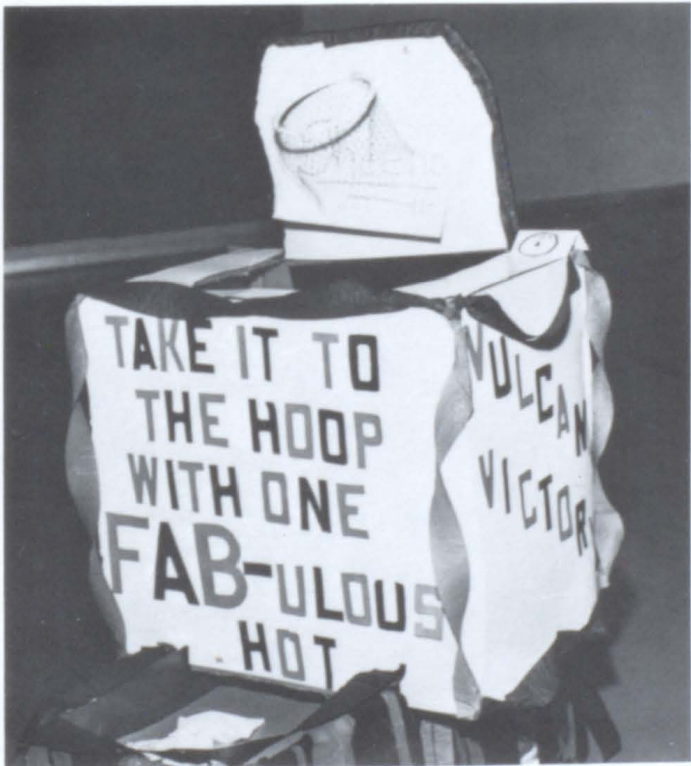
