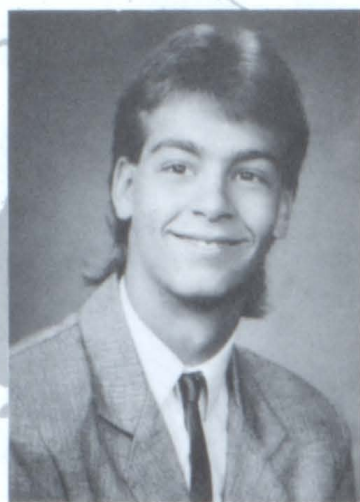
The Wolverines won both the Rose Bowl championship and the NCAA Basketball Championship, giving the University of Michigan the first double title in its history.

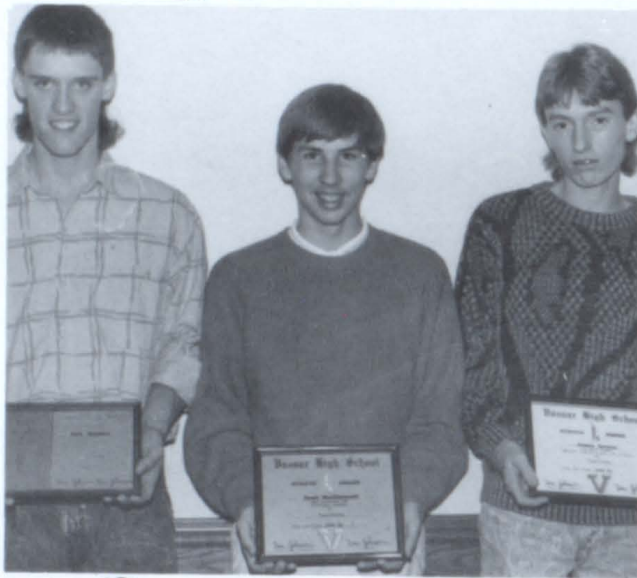

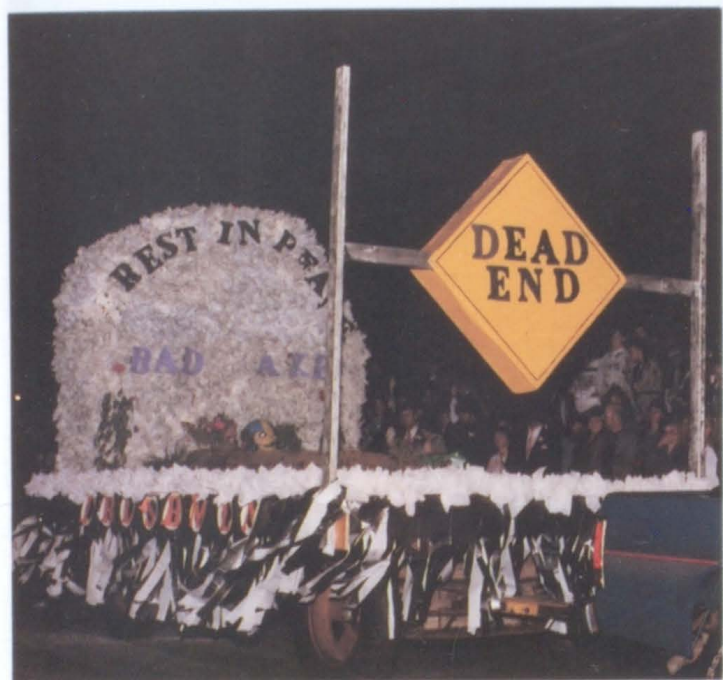

Two Take Early Retirement

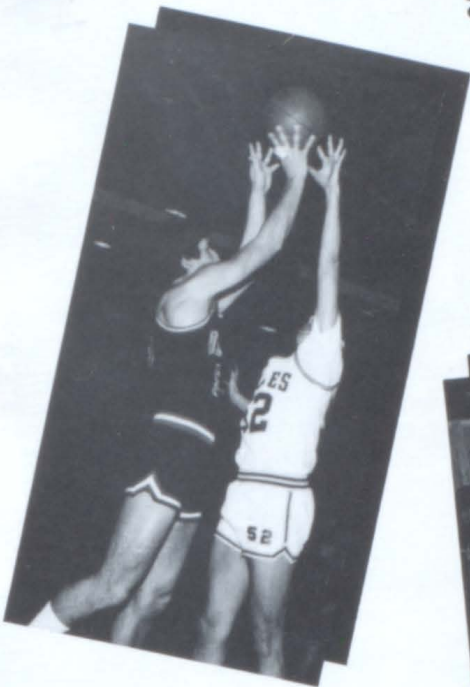

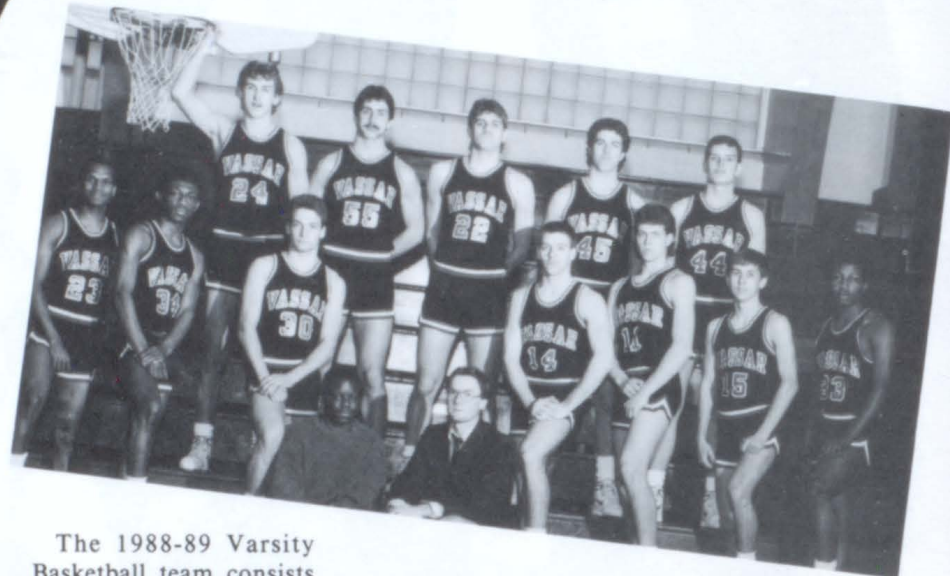

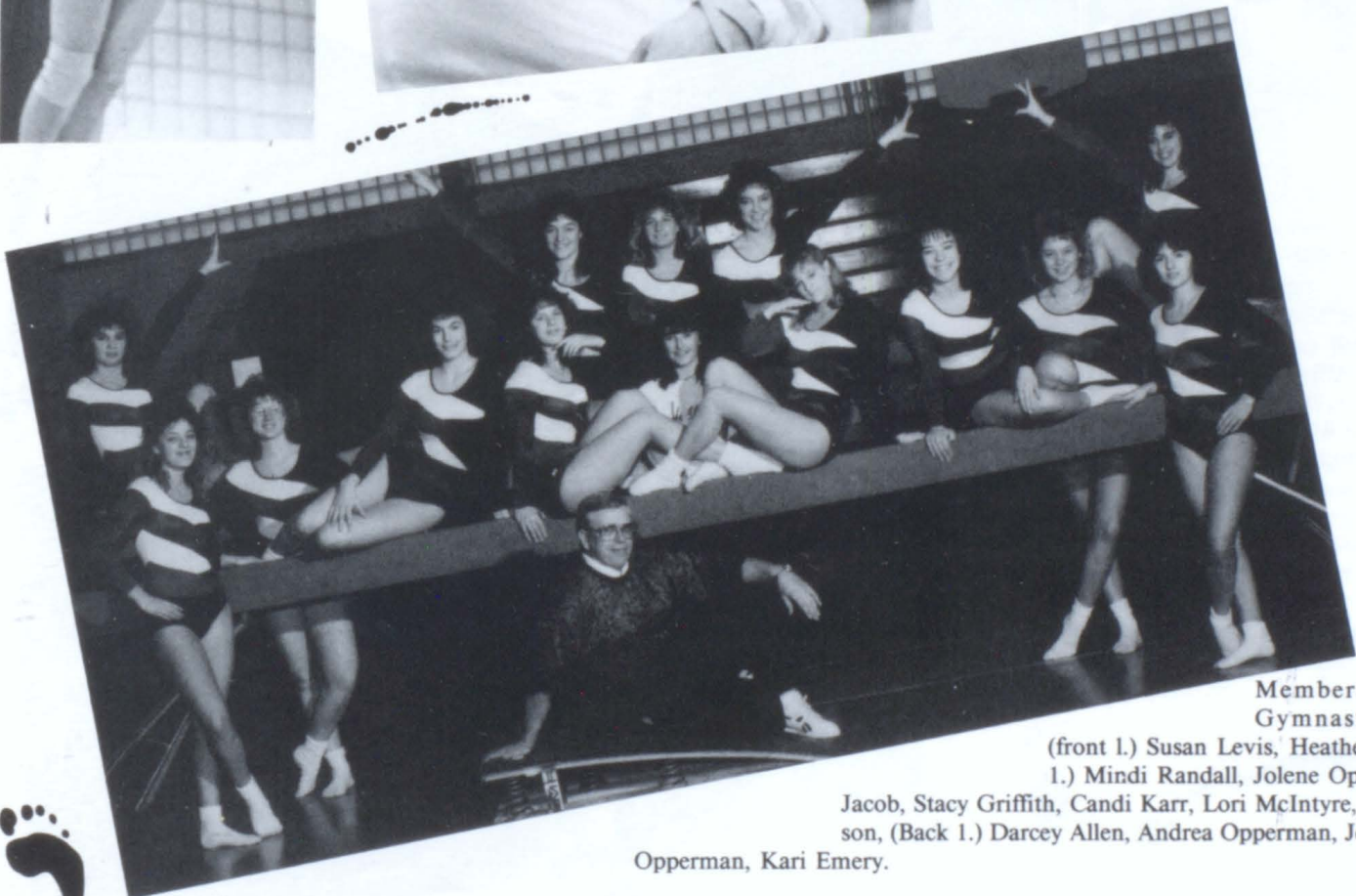

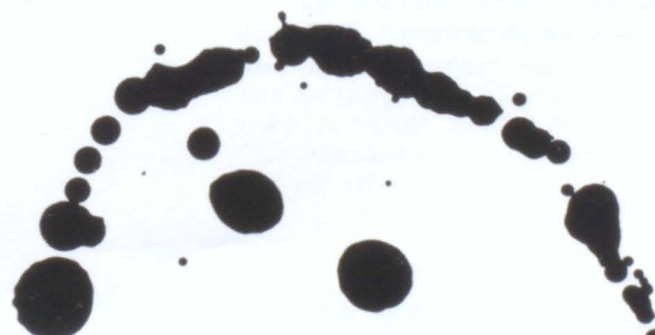

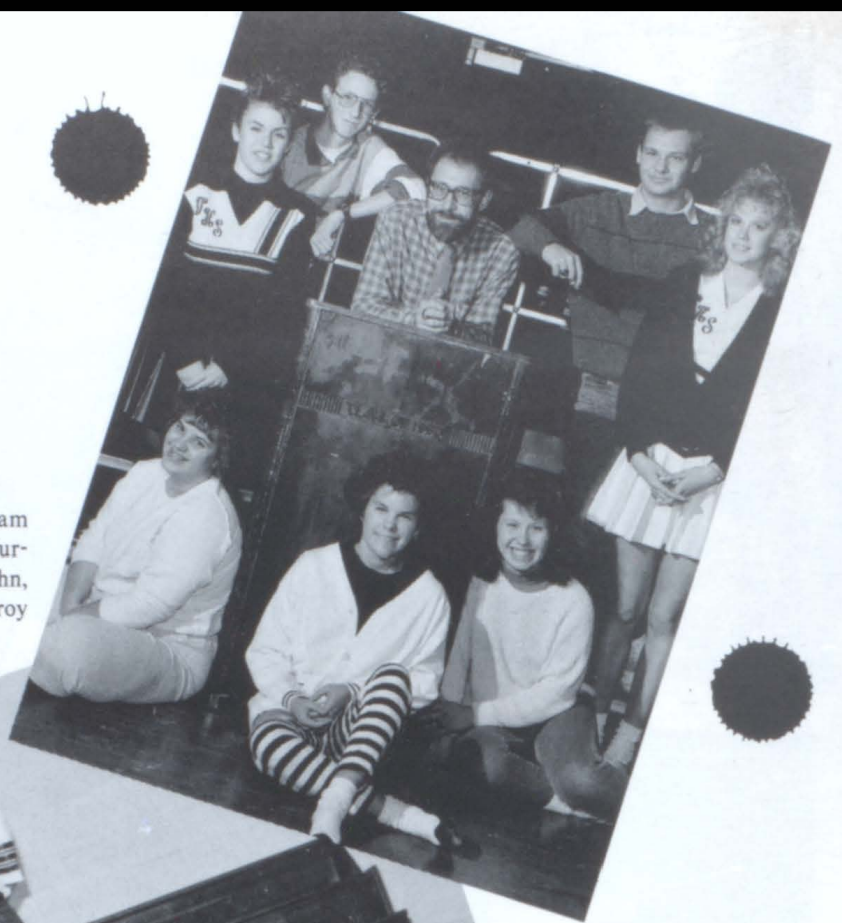

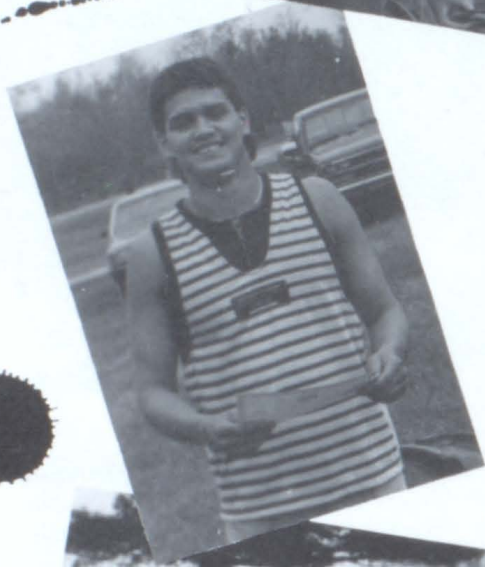
