



















After weeks of preparation and excitement, Homecoming Week finally arrived. Each individual grade showed off its school spirit by participating in the spirit days.

The overall winners of Homecoming 1993 were the Freshmen, in second place were the Juniors, in third the Sophomores, and in last place were Seniors.



VINCENT SHATTERS RECORD!

Senior Jason Vincent has set an all time record for single-season rushing with 1,153 yards on 143 carries. This breaks Jim Baranski's record set in 1973 with 1051 yards. Jason finished second in the area in rushing and first in the league in scoring with 106 points.

Vincent started the year by rushing 100+ yards in the first three games. After a 52-yard game against Caro, Vincent rebounded back to two unbelievable nights of 203-yards against Bridgeport and 208-yards against Birch Run. The last three games of the year Vincent averaged over 100 yards including 183-yards against North Branch, the game in which he broke the record.

Jason's running had much impact on the team this year. He was the team's offensive spark, and he had the ability to make a big play when the team needed it. Vincent doesn't take all the credit himself though. "The only reason I ran so far was due to the outstanding offensive line in front of me," he commented. Jason had a couple of people who influenced him throughout the season. Jason's relationship with his father, Randall Vincent, had much impact on him. Jason comments, "My dad has a big influence on me because I want to impress him." Also he feels that Coach Chapman had one of the most impacts on him because "Mr.Chapman really knows how to motivate you to try your hardest."

KNOLL HEADED FOR N.M.U.

Senior Randy Knoll has chosen to attend Northern Michigan University. After months of debating, Knoll chose Northern over many other colleges. Knoll was also recruited by Saginaw Valley State, Ferris State, and GrandValley State. While on his football scholarship, Knoll will be studying Business Management. Knoll commented, "Although it is very cold in Marquette, I will be playing in the Northern's Superior Dome. The coaches were a large part of my decision, because they stressed academics along with athletics."

Knoll, 6-3 and 215, made 41 solo tackles, and 35 assists. He also caused 6 fumbles, 5 of which he recovered. On the offensive side, Knoll caught 25 passes for 238 yards. He also handled the team's kickoff and extra-point duties. From his linebacker position and his tight end position Knoll has been unanimously selected first-team Tri-Valley Conference the last two years. Knoll was also selected on the Saginaw News Dream Team. For the last two years he's been named to the Detroit Free Press's Honorable Mention All-State.

"He's the best kid I have had in the last 20 years, not in just football but also in school and as a person," stated Coach Chapman.

Knoll is also very well known in basketball, baseball, and track. He has received All-Conference awards in basketball and track. Randy, who is graduating with a 3.4 grade point average received the Alpha Beta award for each of his first three years at Vassar.

Josh Asperger, a classmate of Randy Knoll said, "Randy is a very supportive and is a positive influence on everyone."

DAN & JEFF'S AUTOMATED CHRISTMAS LOCKER




The Vulcans started off the season against Carrollton.






The Lady Vulcans finished with a record of 8-13 including districts. Their conference was much improved from last year going 5-9.






Gymnasts compete at Regionals; earn local honors




"It doesn't matter who wins or loses. The attitude and effort will determine who is successful," comments Chapman


regarding his philosophy on football.





Natural Helpers are chosen by a survey given to high school students. They receive at least 30 hours of training in a retreat setting to improve their helping skills and to learn how to help others make their own decisions.

Natural Helpers also experience the special feeling that comes from helping someone else and knowing that they have made a difference.
