Music was provided by Vassar's own D.J. club and Mr. Middlin, who sat in as guest Disc Jockey for the evening.

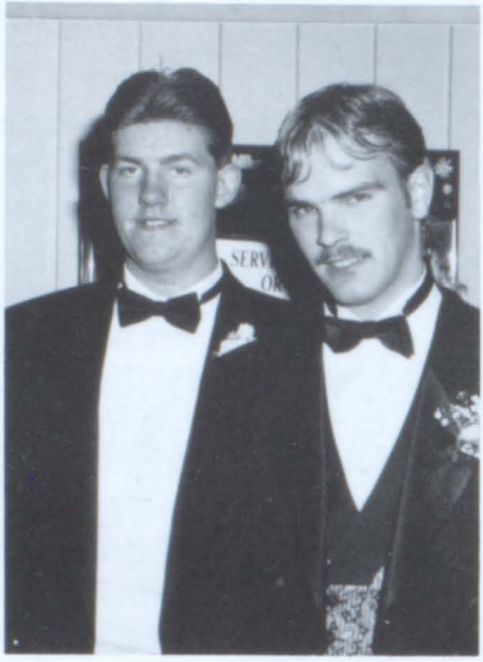

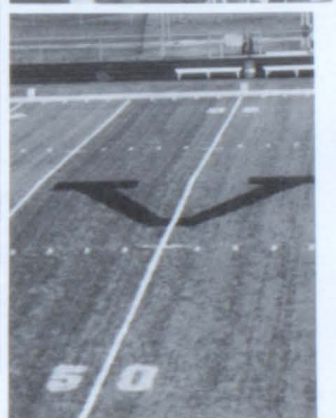
The team finished the season with a record of 4 wins and 5 losses, and were part of a three-way tie for third place in the Eastern Division of the Tri-Valley Conference.

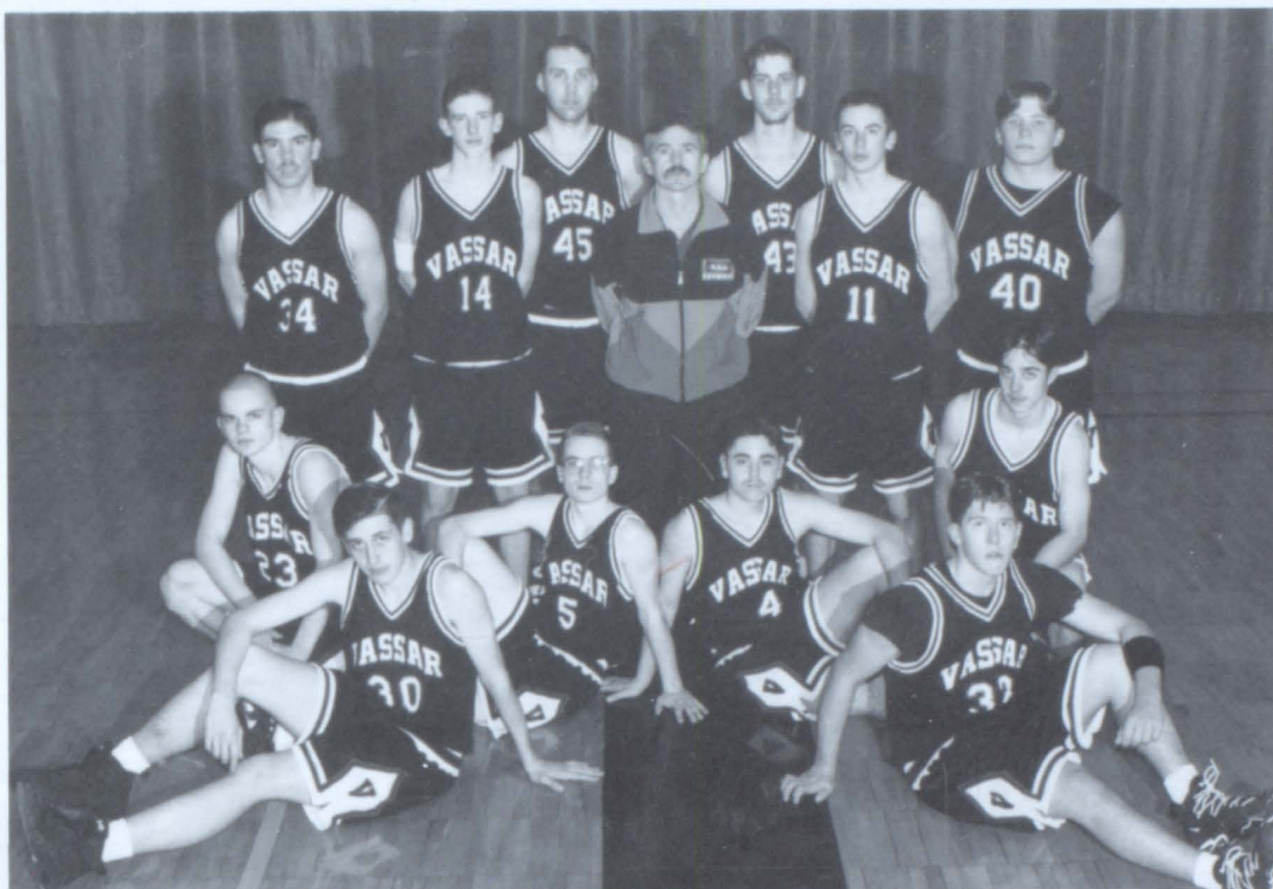

Vulcan Cager Season Ends On A Down Note

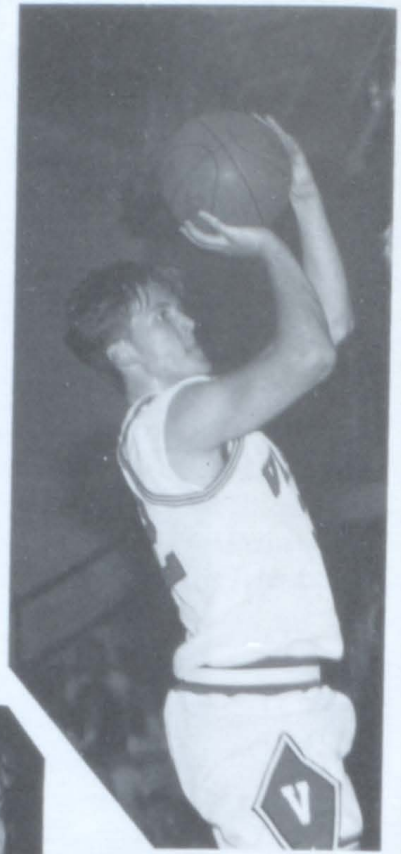

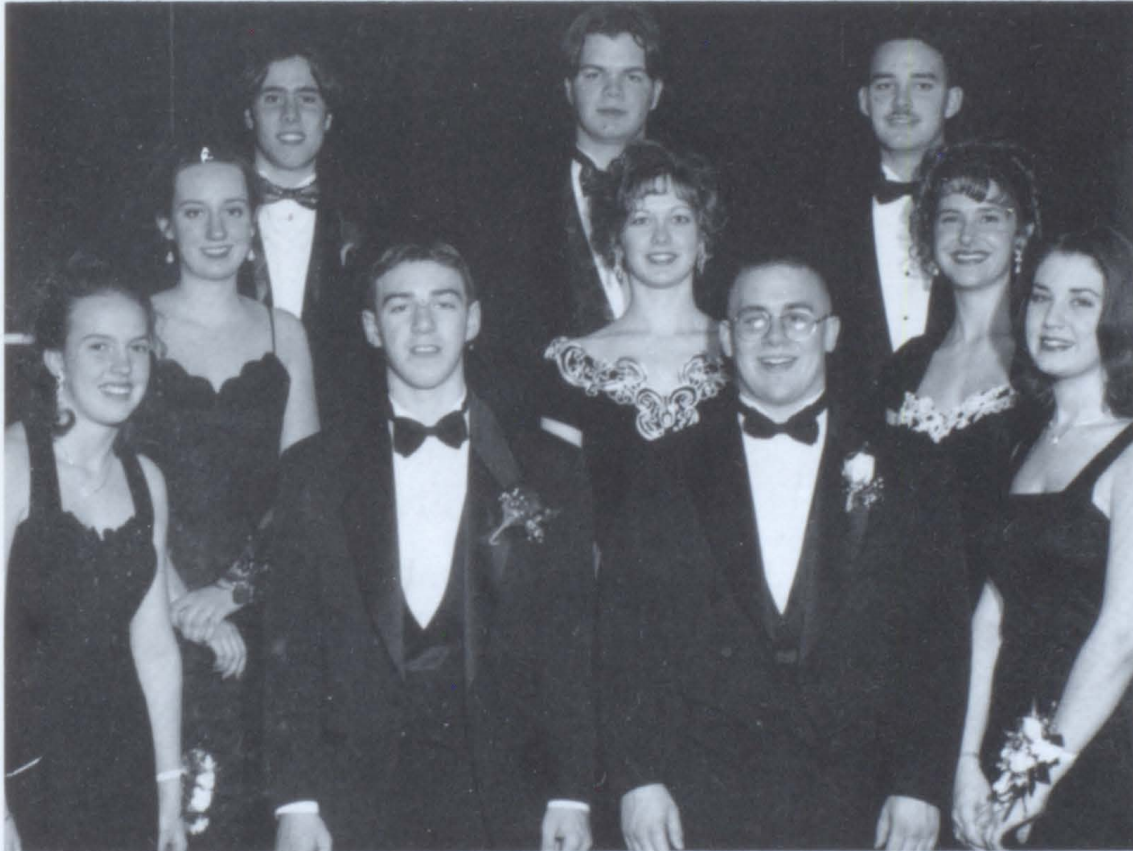

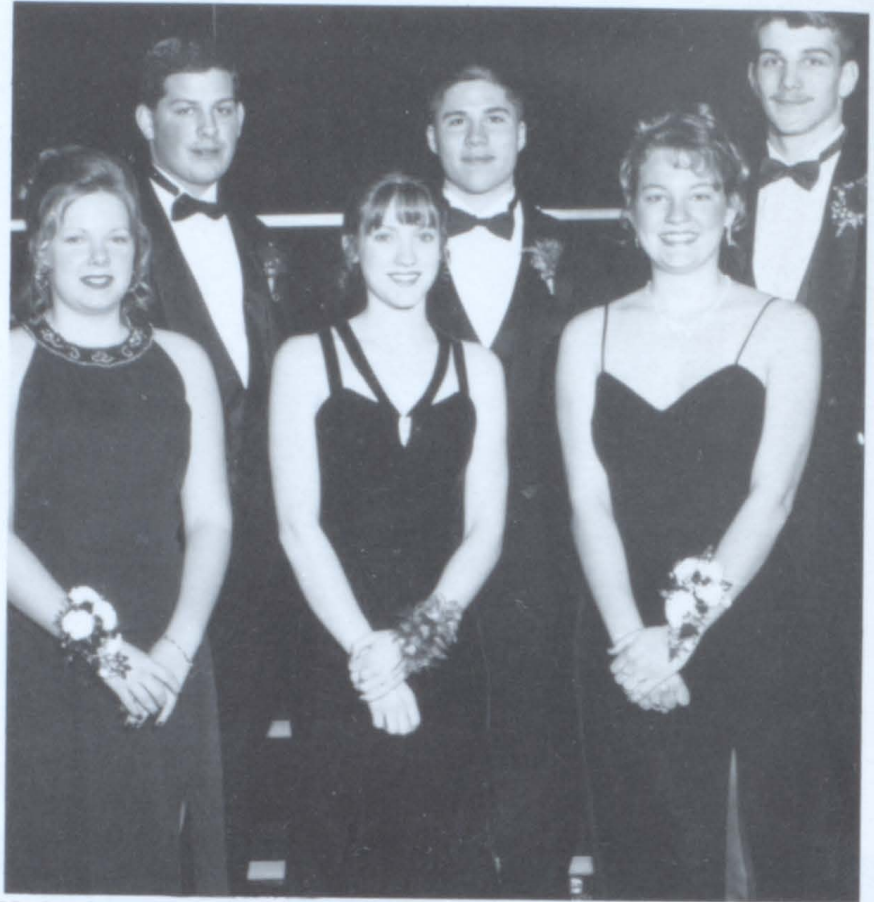

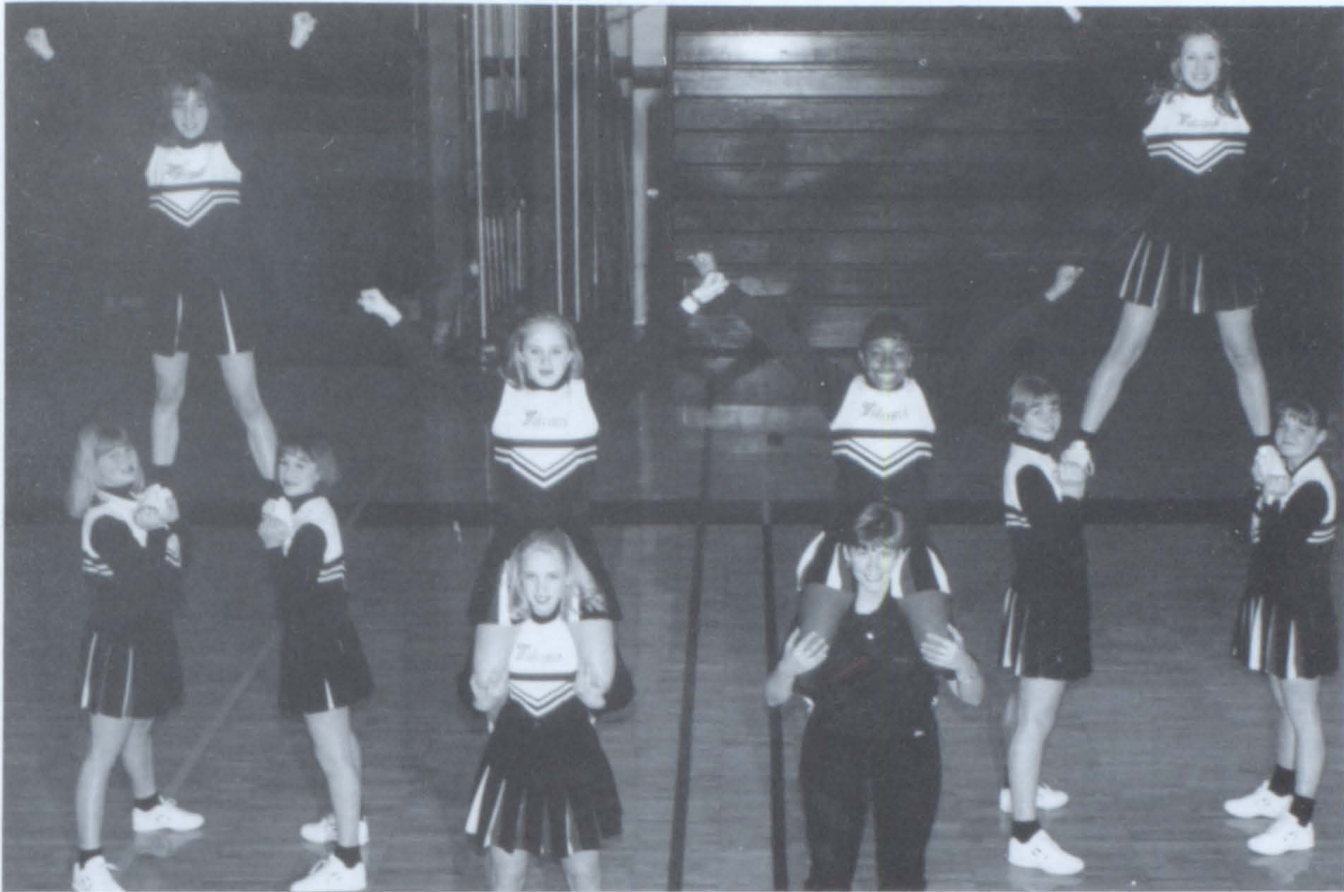

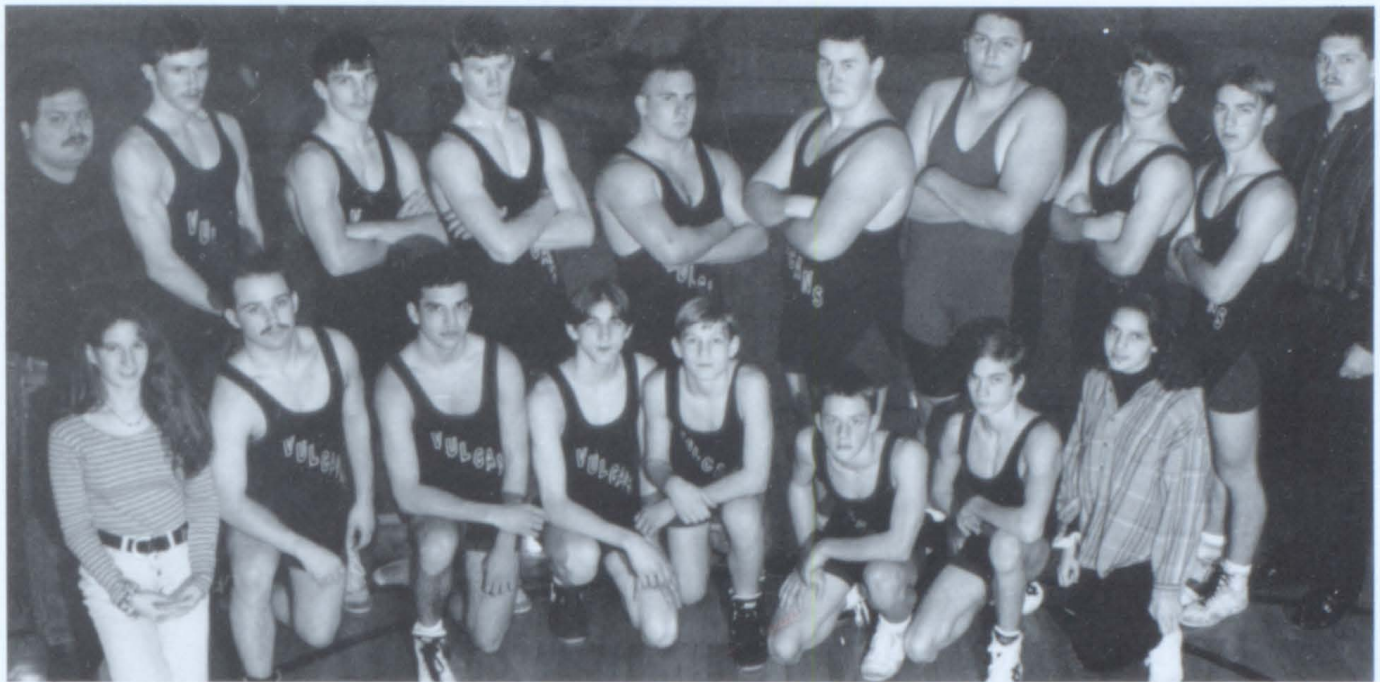

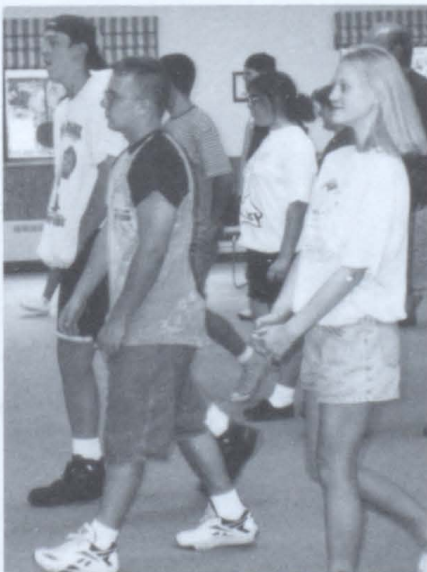

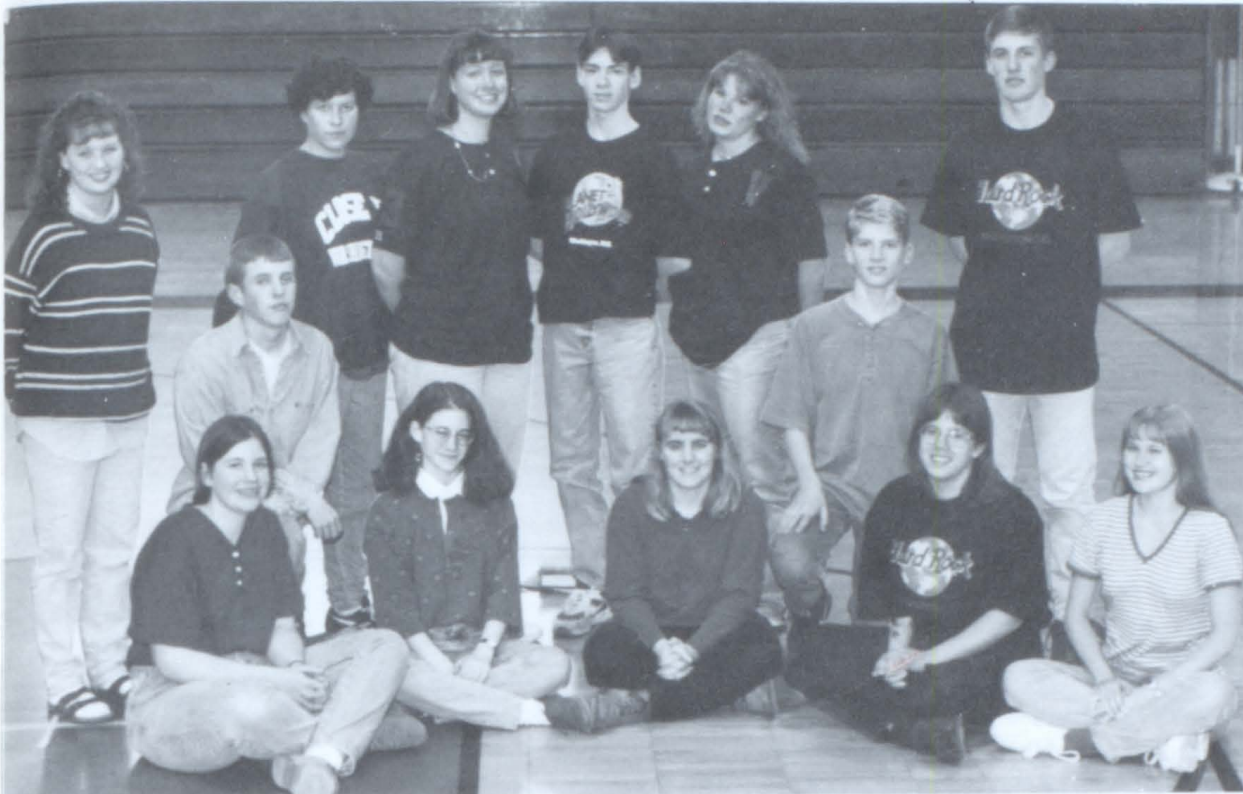
