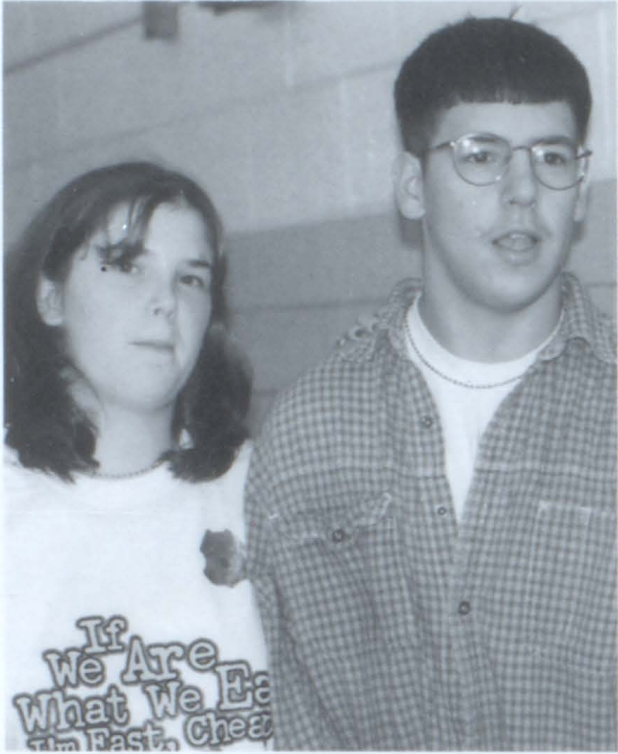

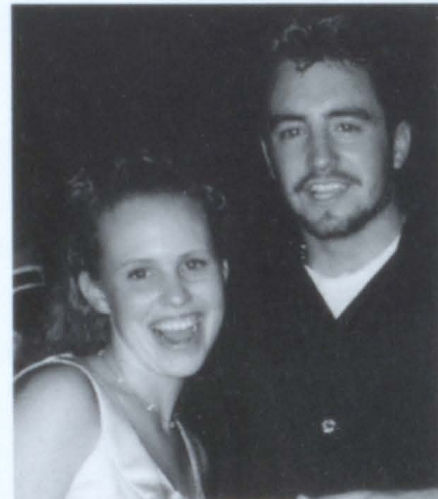
Vassar High School's junior and senior Prom took place May 1st at Bridgeport's Candlelight Banquet rooms. The night can easily be summerized as energetic and fun.

At 6:00 p.m. over 200 elegantly dressed students arrived in everything including sports cars, campers, carriages, limos, buses, and vans.

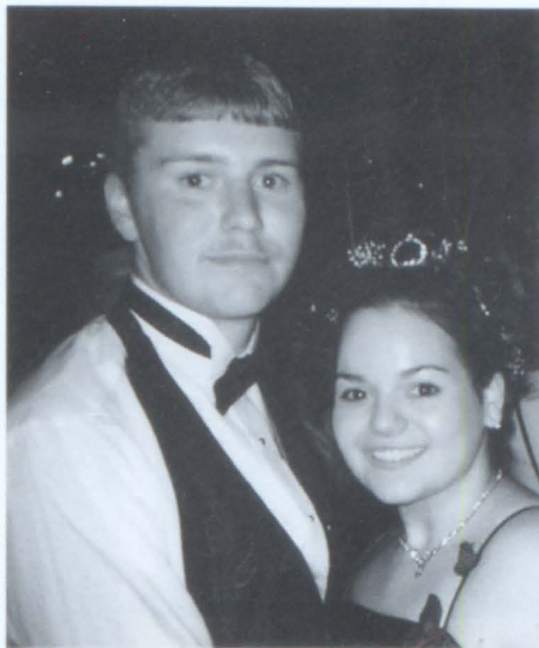
